

Appositives Additional Practice

What are Appositives?

An appositive is a noun or noun phrase that renames or provides additional information about another noun right next to it. Appositives can be essential to the meaning of the sentence or non-essential (which means they can be removed without changing the overall meaning).

Types of Appositives:

1. Essential Appositives: These provide crucial information about the noun. They do not require commas.
 - Example: My brother Sam is coming to visit.
2. Non-essential Appositives: These add extra information and are set off by commas.
 - Example: My brother, Sam, is coming to visit.

How to Identify Appositives:

1. Look for a noun or noun phrase that follows or precedes another noun.
2. Determine if it renames the noun or provides additional information.
3. Check if it's essential or non-essential by seeing if the sentence still makes sense without it.
