## Penalties

- Works Cited entries not cited in paper, or cited sources not on Works Cited page (5-20 point penalty)
- Paper does not cite at least 5 sources (-30 for each one missing)
- Paper does not cite at least one print, one internet, and one database source (-60 points)
- Printouts incomplete or in a different format than cited (penalty varies; 10 point minimum)
- Unreliable/inappropriate sources (penalty varies; -20 points at least for each source)
- Note cards (at least 12 that are used in the paper) missing or not verbatim from source (-3 for each missing card)
- More than two quotations (-6 for each)
- Plagiarism (penalty varies)
  - a. Information not documented
  - b. Quotes not indicated as quotes
  - c. Paraphrases too similar to source or not cited
- Paper does not stick to topic (or lapses into summary) or does not have three paragraphs that support the stance (penalty varies)
- Does not meet length requirement of at least three FULL typed pages (penalty varies)
- Excessive grammatical or formatting errors (penalty varies)
- The word "critics" should not be used in thesis, topic sent., or concluding sent. (-2 for each)
- Lateness (-40 points for every day it is late)
